Jim MacCatain volunteered to provide refreshments on November 9 2021.

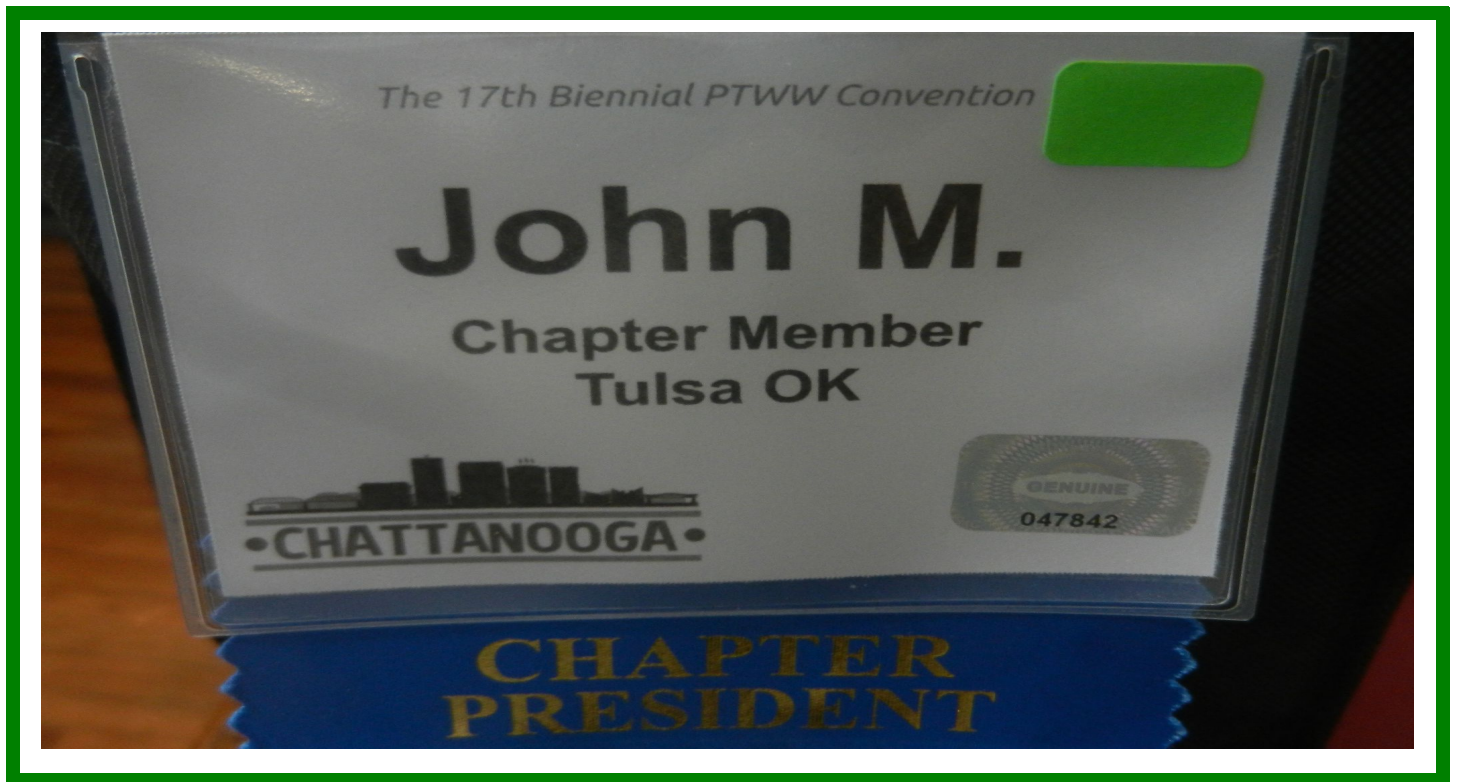
Chuck Cagle moved for adjournment. Seconded Jim MacCatain. Motion carried.

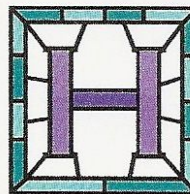

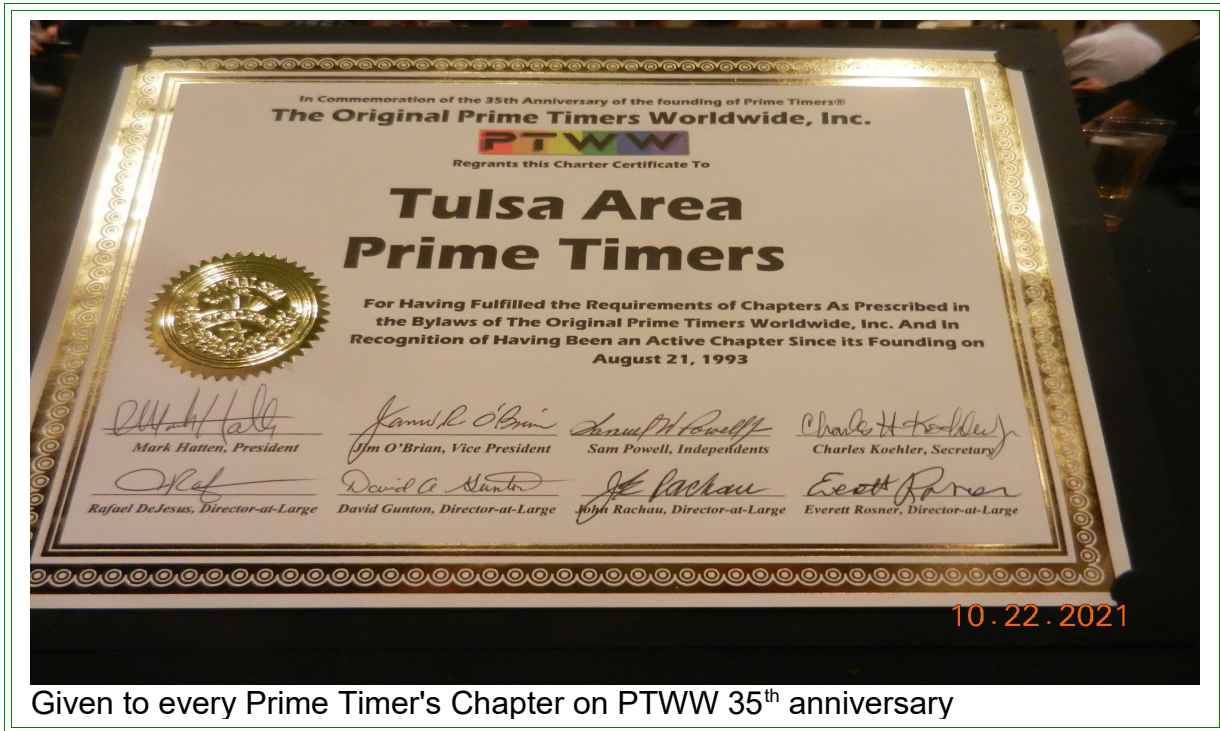
